BABY CARE- ONLINE CLASSES AND IN-HOME SUPPORT

Babies do not come with instruction books, but there is a way to "figure them out." Prenatal education is a great way to feel confident when heading home with your newborn. Classes cover: Newborn Appearance, Crying and Comfort, Feeding Basics, Diapering, Dressing, Health and Safety, Choosing a Pediatrician, and What to Expect in the first few weeks at home.

Once home, a Baby Care Consult will focus on ensuring your comfort in caring for your newborn. A nurse will review your baby's appearance, health, and safety, help with your first sponge bath, answer questions regarding diapering, dressing, and swaddling, discuss feeding (not a full lactation consultation) and answer any questions or concerns you have.

BREASTFEEDING EDUCATION AND LACTATION CONSULTATIONS

While breastfeeding is natural and recommended, it is a learned skill. Prenatal preparation can enhance confidence and start your breastfeeding journey off on a smoother note.

Classes Cover: Breast Anatomy/ Milk Production

Nipple Shapes (Erect, Dimpled, Inverted)

What to expect immediately after delivery.

The first 24 hours- Intake and Output, Newborn norms

Second Day Syndrome- Intake and Output- Cluster Feeding-Challenges (increased bilirubin, latching problems)

Day 3 – Day 5 Expectations-Mature Milk Production Comfort-Challenges, Supplementation, Paced-Bottle Feeding Pumping and Returning to Work.

An In-Home Lactation Consultation within the first few days will set you up for breastfeeding success. Focusing on proper latching, positioning, pumping, nipple care, and paced-bottle feeding. A plan of care will be developed and provided to ensure confidence post-consultation. Parents will have the ability to text for further help post-consult.
